I could see:

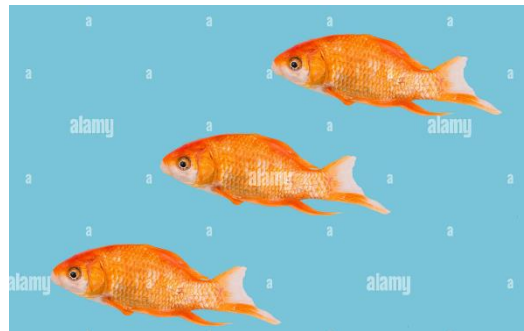
5 digging dogs
