Personal, Social & Emotional Development:

The main focus in this area will be separating from our parents without any tears as we get used to our new routine. Independently accessing the activities in the new environment and share our likes, dislikes, needs and feelings.

Communication & Language:

The children will be using short sentences to hold conversations with adults and peers as we all build a positive relationship and begin to develop a wider range of vocabulary.

We will also be expected to listen for short periods of time and recall information.

Physical Development:

This term we will be working on our gross motor movements focusing on balancing, hopping and jumping with both feet. We will also be using large scale movements to wave streamers and make marks– these are the first step to us becoming writers.

We will also be trying to increase our control when using one handed tools such as scissors and tweezers.

Our P.E day will be a Friday and children will need to wear their P.E kits to school on this day.

Maths:

This term in Maths we will be focusing on colours. We will be naming colours, matching and sorting.

We will also begin to look at number, number shapes and subitising.

Understanding the World:

This term will look at our families and individual cultures as we make sense of our own lives and family history.

We will also be using all of our senses to explore new ob-
