Differentiation:

Beginner Identify the grammatically correct sentence where four options are given in simple past or simple present. Aimed at Year 2 Developing.

Easy Identify the grammatically correct sentence where four options are given in past progressive, simple progressive or future tense. Aimed at Year 2 Expected/Year 4 Emerging.

Tricky Identify the grammatically correct sentence where four options are given in sentences with verbs in Standard English form, including the future tense. Aimed at Year 4 Expected/Year 6 Emerging.

Expert Identify the grammatically correct sentence where four options are given in sentences with verbs in the subjunctive form or future tense. Aimed at Year 6 Expected.
