Autumn 1 Reception Overview



Personal, Social & Emotional Development:

This half term we will be learning the rules and expectations of Reception, making friends and exploring our classroom. We will be working on listening skills and following instructions. We will be focusing on feelings and how to express them appropriately with one another. We will be developing our independence - using the lunch hall, looking after our things and making our own snack.

Communication & Language:

As we settle in we will be speaking and listening in turn to each other as we share 'all about me'. We will be singing lots of rhymes and songs to encourage our speech. Our focus this half term will be listening and language skills as we explore new vocabulary through our story theme 'Super Duper Me'.

Physical Development:

We will start out our year with gymnastics as our PE unit to help build core strength and develop fundamental movement patterns. Our fine motor will be developed as we complete finger challenges and introduce letter formation.

Our PE day is Wednesday.

Maths:

This half term we will build on our number skills from Nursery starting with subitising. We will be recapping numbers to 5 and making different arrangements with numbers. We will see if we can spot what smaller numbers are hiding in bigger numbers as we start to understand number composition.

Understanding the World:

By half term we will be able to talk about people who are special to us, special places and about our homes and families. We will be sharing what makes us unique as we explore similarities and differences with one another. As Autumn approaches we will learn about the changes we might see in our natural world.

Phonics

Phonics will begin in week 3 when we have settled in and we will start with phonemes which are single letters which make 1 sound. Please check your child's planner regularly for each weeks phonics sounds to practise at home. Access Little Wandle online for more parent guidance.

By half term we will have covered the sounds:

Expressive Arts & Design:

Songs and rhymes will be our focus this half term as we learn to express ourselves through music and movement. We will be attending singing assembly every Tuesday. Our classroom creative area is stocked and ready to go so we can explore colour mixing, painting techniques and printing this half term.
