



Year 6's Curriculum Map for Autumn Term

Our Topic is: Crime and Punishment

For this term we aim to teach the following:



English

Our learning will centre around the books 'Holes'. There will look at many other stories too where we will cover the following genres:

- Description
- Journalistic Writing
- Poetry
- Flash Back Stories
- Information Texts

Throughout, we will cover specific sentence types and grammar to develop our children's knowledge of writing.

History

We will learn about Crime and Punishment through history focusing on the eras; The Romans, Anglo Saxons, Tudors, Victorians and Modern Times. This will develop our understanding of chronology. We aim to find out if our era is the fairest of all.

Computing

For the Autumn Term our Computing focus will be on ESafety. They will be accessing programs using J2E to further develop their understanding of this area.

RE

We will investigate ceremonies associated with joining or belonging to the Sikhism and Hinduism community and talk about the meaning of commitment.

DT/Art

We will be creating artwork centred around the Roman Laws called 'The Twelve Tables'. We will also start developing our sketching skills and creating a final sketch of Scrooge.

Maths

We will cover the following units:

Place Value
All 4 operations (+ x ÷ -)
Fractions
Position and Direction

Continuing this year are Maths Meetings which will take place twice a week for half an hour and will cover many different objectives.

Morning Maths will still continue and this year the children have the opportunity to reach Platinum level!

PSHE

We will learn to recognise our worth as individuals whilst looking at the different roles and responsibilities in and outside of school.

Science

Our area of study this term is Animals Including Humans

We will be learning about the circulatory system and we will be

- identifying the main parts of the circulatory system
- describing their functions
- Exploring how nutrients and water are transported in plants and animals

The effects of drugs, diet and exercise on the body.

Languages: Spanish!

We will continue to learn Spanish and use a program called Language Angels. This term they build on their basic knowledge of numbers and greetings from last year, extending into new vocabulary.

Geography

We will be looking at following map directions using 4 figure co-ordinates as well as identifying countries on a world map.

Music

This term we will be having our Keyboard lessons taught by a specialist set up in the new keyboard room! Very exciting!

The Year 6 PE slot will be a Thursday. Children can come in their PE kit on this day. All hair tied up and no jewellery worn on this day please. They will be completing units on gymnastics and dance.
