



Year 5's Curriculum Map for Autumn Term

Our Topic is: Did The Ancient Greeks Have Human Rights?

For this term we aim to teach the following:



English

Our learning for the Autumn will focus on a range of genres from Mythological Stories and Poetry to Biographies and Information Texts.

Children will be retelling stories, writing and performing poetry learning about famous influential people and how to write persuasively.

Throughout this, we will cover specific sentence types and grammar to develop our children's knowledge of writing.

Maths

Place Value

Addition and Subtraction

Multiplication and Division

Fractions

Children will also practise mental maths during Maths Meetings. These will take place twice a week for half an hour and will cover addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions and times tables games. Morning Maths will still continue.

Science

Our area of study this term is 'Materials' and 'Forces', where we will conduct Scientific Enquiry through testing and investigations. Children will compare properties of materials and learn about reversible and irreversible changes.

Children will identify the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction, that act between moving surfaces. Children will also learn that sometimes a smaller force can have a greater effect.

History

In history, children will be learning about the Ancient Greeks and whether or not they had human rights. Children will learn about key historical figures as well as Ancient Greek beliefs and life styles.

Music

Children will be learning to play the Keyboard. Children will play and perform using the keyboard with increasing accuracy. Children will use and understand staff and other musical notations and pupils will group to perform a piece of music.

Languages: Spanish

In Spanish children will be looking at the seasons and the weather, building on prior knowledge of dates. Children will learn to describe the weather and give a small presentation.

Computing

This half term children will be learning about E-Safety. Children will learn how to stay safe on line including online relationships, responsible choices, self image and identity, on-line bullying and App safety. Children will also learn about infographics where they will learn how to present information and use charts, graphs and tables.

RE: In RE we will be exploring the sacred writings from different religions and how the impact the day to day lives of people of faith with a focus on the story of Rama and Sita during Diwali. We will also be exploring the topic of peace and looking at artwork and symbols that represent the different ways people feel and show peace. We will be looking at different stories from the bible that discuss the topic.

PSHE: Children will recognise their worth as individuals, see their mistakes, make amends and set personal goals.

Art

In Art, we will learning about different gradients of pencils and practise techniques learnt in LKS2 (texture, line, tone etc) to create specific effects. Children will also learn about shading in various styles as well as light, shadow and reflection.
